
This complicated implementation needs a high-level company overview combined with detailed knowledge on operational requirements

The Issue:

There are three main phases of implementing a new WMS:

- 1) Setting up the WMS requirements
- 2) Comparing requirements with WMS-provider offers
- 3) WMS-implementation

Each phase is crucial for a successful WMS-installation and missing out on even a few items can result in a risk for operational effectiveness causing cost- and time-consuming recoveries
